

Helpful Hints For Macintosh Users

There is very little difference between using Educator with a PC and using Educator with a Macintosh. There are, however, several things to keep in mind. These include:

1. You must include a file extension when saving your files to upload to the Educator. For example, when you save a Microsoft Word document, you should give it a name and end the name with .doc If I want to upload a file called assignment1 from Word, I should save it as assignment1.doc Some other useful extension (file types) to remember are:
 - .doc - Word Documents
 - .ppt - PowerPoint
 - .xls Excel Documents
2. All Educator Chat boards work on either browser on the Macintosh
