

Faculty Directions Enrolling and Entering Your Course as a Student

When you use Educator, it is often useful to be able to see the same things your students see. With Educator it is very easy to do!

Enrolling and Entering Your Course as a Student:

1. Make sure you have logged into Educator and are in the course you wish to enter (view) as a student.
2. Scroll down to the bottom of the screen and you will see several icons.



3. Click on the **View As Learner**. The first time you select this option, as screen will appear describing that you are about to enroll yourself as a student in the course. You can click the **Continue** button to enter your course as a student, or use the browser **Back** button to abort the process. Click the **Continue** button and you will enroll yourself as a student and go to the student view.
4. To go back to the Instructor's view, scroll down to the bottom of the screen and you will see a set of similar icons:



5. Click on the **View as Instructor** and you will be back in the instructor's view.
6. You are now enrolled as a student in your course. You can check this by clicking on the navigation area – **Course Manager**. Scroll down the list of courses and your should see something similar to:
