## Search Reserves

by Course

To search by COURSE, type in as much of the course name as you know, or enter in the course abbreviation. **CSU and CUW patrons** should include 'csu' or 'cuw' before the course name..(i.e., **cuw nurs 302**).  
 Examples:

- HIS 362
- Introduction to Fashion
- Zoology 201
- Organic Chemistry
- CSU PS 201

To search by INSTRUCTOR, type as much or as little of the name as you wish. For example:

- Miller

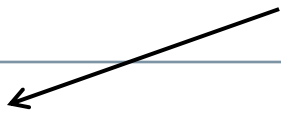
